

NEW STATE REQUIREMENTS REGARDING MEDICATION

**Please be advised that the following guidelines are in conjunction with the State of New Jersey Department of Children and Families Office of Licensing. Failure to comply will result in termination of all PrimeTime child care services.*

If your child requires and Epi-Pen:

- The Epi-Pen must be provided to PrimeTime before the start of the school year
- The Epi-Pen must be in its original box
- 2-Paks **CANNOT** be separated
- The allergy action plan must be filled out and signed by a doctor
- A current Epi-Pen must be provided prior to the one on site expiring

If your child requires an Inhaler:

- The Inhaler must be provided to PrimeTime before the start of the school year
- The Inhaler must be in its original box
- The asthma action plan must be filled out and signed by a doctor
- A current inhaler must be provided prior to the one on site expiring

If your child requires any other form of Medication: (Antihistamine, Etc.)

- The medication must be provided to PrimeTime before the start of the school year
- The medication must be in its original box
- An action plan must be filled out and signed by a doctor
- Current medication must be provided prior to the one on site expiring
